This program's intent is to expose students to the many areas in Marine Technology. Marine Technology is a hands-on competency based program which centers instruction around the various areas associated with the Marine Industry.



Students are exposed to the following areas of instruction in their first year in Marine Technology. Boat Design and Construction, Fiberglass Construction and Repair, Recreational Fishing Gear Construction, Boating Safety and Handling, Marlinespike Seamanship (rope tying and splicing), Outboard, Inboard, and Inboard/Outboard Engine Mechanics, Welding and Metalworking, Marine Systems, Shop Safety and Proper Machine/Tool use, Vessel Transportation, Marina Operations and Yard Services, Wood Joinery and Finishes.
