


Islesford Boatworks

Wooden Boatbuilding Program

Through the boatbuilding shop, housed in an 800 sq.ft. barn on Little Cranberry Island, Islesford Boatworks has taught the traditional craft of wooden boatbuilding to an average of 70 children and 80 adults each summer, in a 6-8 week summer program. Over 500 individual students have attended over the past 11 years, many attending year after year.

All participants work on the same project, Harry Bryans “Thistle”, a 12’ pedal powered sailboat. We breakdown our groups based on a combination of age and experience, offering Beginners, Intermediate and Advanced Youth program, and an Adult program
