Marine Career Technical Education Program

MCTEP is a career education program that enables high school graduates to secure entry level positions and/or higher education degrees leading to a merchant marine career. Upon graduation from MACTEP, graduates are able to begin a career on a commercial vessel; be recommended for congressional appointment to the US Merchant Marine Academy, Kings Point, New York; combine merchant marine experience with an officer training program; attend a two/four-year college; or attend one of five federally funded state maritime academies for graduate and undergraduate programs leading to licensed mariners careers and/or shore side occupations.



Boat Building I and II are critical components of the MCTEP curriculum design. These two courses are offered in Year I of the three year program. Additionally, students in grades 5- 8 study nautical traditions and in the course of their studies complete a variety of small boat and model boat building projects. The 21st Century After-School Enrichment Program also includes boat building courses throughout the school year and summer months.
