

Maritime Academy Charter School

Maritime Charter School is a K-12 Primary and Secondary Charter School in Philadelphia, PA.

The school opened in 2003 with 128 4th and 5th grade students in leased classrooms. Since that time the school has expanded, grown and developed. The school presently operates in five buildings at two locations in the city. There are over 800 students enrolled in grades 2-12. The program integrates “Marinates” the standard state academic curriculum in grades 2-8. In high school students take an “Introduction to Maritime Studies, Education and Careers course in 9th grade. They then select from one of four educational pathways. The pathways include Maritime Studies, Oceanography/Meteorology, Transportation/Logistics or a traditional high school college prep program.



Graduates are presently attending SUNY Maritime College, SIU Piney Point Apprentice Program, working for a marine employer or have enlisted in U.S. Coast Guard or Navy.
